Directions: For the AP Psychology Summer Project, you will be reading and applying each chapter in the “Myers’ Psychology for AP” textbook. Utilizing the SQ3R method of reading comprehension, you will Survey, Question, Read, Recite, and Review the **three** of the first 7 chapters and the concepts within them. Again, you will only choose three chapters.

To do this, you will follow the template laid out below for each chapter. The template will be completely filled out, and hand-written by the end of the summer. No more, and no less will be required.

The summer project is the first large part of the course. This is not a project to take lightly, as it will prepare you for the content surrounding each chapter for the remainder of the year.
