
Dear Camper,

WAPAKONETA ELEMENTARY FOOTBALL CAMP

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The *Wapakoneta Football Camp* is designed for students entering grades one through six next fall.

ABOUT THE CAMP

The *Wapakoneta Football Camp* is designed to help participants improve basic skills and learn the techniques of football. Demonstrations and drill sessions requiring limited physical contact are held daily under the guidance of the Wapakoneta football coaching staff. Staff members are available to give individual attention. Sessions are held daily and are conducted on the grass fields or, in the event of inclement weather, in the indoor facility.

LOCATION

All the Wapakoneta football camps are conducted on Wapakoneta's campus. All campers that attend Wapakoneta Elementary School should report directly after school to the elementary gymnasium. All campers that attend Cridersville Elementary School will report to the Wapakoneta Elementary School gymnasium. The football staff will assist students from the gymnasium to the high school football practice fields at 3:10. All campers that attend Wapakoneta Middle School will report to the high school cafeteria. Campers can be picked up at the high school football practice fields at 5:00 p.m.

REGISTRATION & FEES

To enroll a student in the camp, a parent or guardian should complete all parts of the registration form and send it, with full payment, to Wapakoneta. The cost of the camp is \$40 per person and \$20 for any additional family member enrolled in this year's camp. Please make checks payable to Wapakoneta Athletic Boosters (Football) and return registration to: Travis Moyer, Football Coach, Wapakoneta High School, 1 W. Redskin Trail, Wapakoneta, OH 45895 or to your child's teacher.

Registration deadline is Friday April 30th. All registrations received after April 30th, the cost of the camp will be \$45.00 per person and \$20.00 for any additional family member enrolled.

Walk-in registration on the day the camp opens cannot be guaranteed.

Each camper will receive an official 2021 *Wapakoneta Football Camp* t-shirt and sack pack. Campers will receive a meal and camp awards will be given out.
